MOVE UPS

Move-Up entries will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date, August 22, 2007. A “move up sheet” or email to the Trial Secretary with the dog’s move-up information must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6:00p.m., September 10, 2007. Move-ups are not allowed from Novice A to Novice B. Dogs so moved up will run at the end of the running order. Move-ups can only be accepted providing judging limits are not exceeded.

JUMP HEIGHT CARDS

“Starting January 1, 2001, all dogs that do not have a permanent or valid temporary Jump Height Card issued by the AKC shall be measured by a judge of record prior to competing.”

PLEASE ENCLOSE A COPY OF YOUR JUMP HEIGHT CARD WITH YOUR ENTRY, AND HAVE YOUR CARD WITH YOU AT THE TRIAL. MEASURING DOGS WITHOUT CARDS WILL TAKE PLACE PRIOR TO JUDGING OF STANDARD AND JWW CLASSES.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All height divisions will be offered in both the Standard and Jumpers with Weaves classes. Dogs in Preferred classes MUST jump their measured height and may not jump in a higher height or any qualifying scores or placements will be disallowed. Therefore, if you are unsure of your dog’s correct jump height, please enter the lower height and if necessary your dog will be moved to their higher height.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians’ recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

OBSTACLES

Obstacles will conform to the current requirements of the Agility Regulations. All jumps are displaceable. Weave Poles mandatory in all Standard and JWW Classes.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION and WARM UPS

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class, following the Judge’s Briefing. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class.

AKC no longer allows obstacle familiarization for Novice dogs.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

REGULAR CLASSES

NOVICE AGILITY CLASS- The Novice agility class is divided into Division A for persons and dogs that have never acquired an AKC agility title, and Novice B for dogs who acquired the Novice Agility Title, persons that have handled a dog to an agility title, and for agility judges.

OPEN AGILITY CLASS- Open to dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility or Open Agility Titles, but have not acquired the Agility Excellent Title.

EXCELLENT AGILITY CLASS- Division A is for dogs that have acquired the Open Agility Title, but have not acquired a qualifying score in the Excellent B Class. Division B is for dogs that have acquired the AX title and for dogs that have acquired the MX title. Qualifying scores for the AX title are acquired in the Excellent A Class, and qualifying scores for the MX title and Master Agility Championship titles are acquired from the Excellent B Class.

NOVICE JUMPERS WITH WEAVES- The Novice Jumpers with Weaves class is divided into division A for persons and dogs that have never acquired an agility title from any organization, and division B for dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility title, persons that have handled a dog to an agility title, and for agility judges.

OPEN JUMPERS WITH WEAVES- Open to all dogs that have acquired the Novice Jumpers with Weaves title, Novice Agility title or Open Agility titles but which have not acquired the Agility Excellent Jumpers with Weaves title.

EXCELLENT JUMPERS WITH WEAVES- Division A is for dogs that have acquired the Open JWW Agility Title, but which have not acquired a qualifying score in the Excellent B Class. Division B is for dogs that have acquired the AXJ title and for dogs that have acquired the MXJ title. Qualifying scores for the AXJ title are acquired in the Excellent A Class, and qualifying scores for the MXJ title and Master Agility Championship titles are acquired from the Excellent B Class.

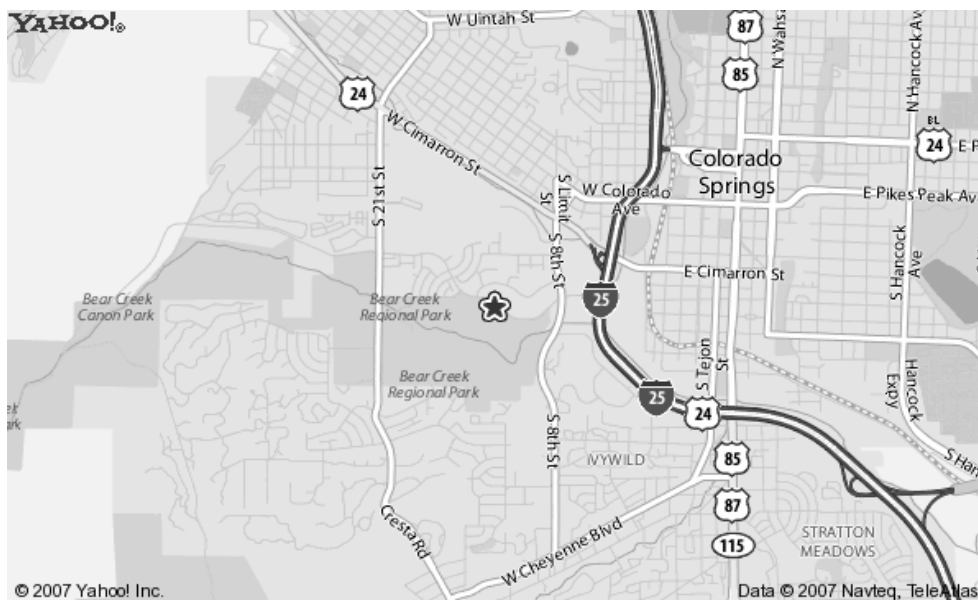
PREFERRED CLASSES

The Preferred Classes are open to any dog eligible to enter an agility trial as defined in Chapter 1, Section 3. The owner may choose to enter the Preferred Classes in lieu of entering the Regular Classes. The dog must be entered only in Regular Classes or only in Preferred Classes, with no crossover between them allowed at the same set of trials. Owners are allowed to switch back and forth between Regular and Preferred Classes, but not at the same set of trials. Dogs entering the Preferred Classes for the first time must enter the Novice level in both Standard and JWW Class regardless of their previous title level in the Regular Classes. The same Regulations apply for divisions A and B as those described for the Regular titling classes (see above) (EXCEPT in Novice, where no A& B divisions exist).

FROM SOUTH: Take I-25 North towards COLO SPGS. Take EXIT 141 MANITOU SPGS / PIKES PEAK / WOODLAND PARK (US-24). Turn LEFT onto W CIMARRON ST / US-24. Turn LEFT onto S 8TH ST. Turn RIGHT onto W RIO GRANDE ST. End at **Norris Penrose Event Center:** 1045 W Rio Grande St, Colorado Springs, CO 80906.

FROM NORTH: Take I-25 South towards COLO SPGS. Take EXIT 141 MANITOU SPGS / PIKES PEAK / WOODLAND PARK (US-24). Merge RIGHT onto W CIMARRON ST / US-24. Turn LEFT onto S 8TH ST. NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

This trial will be conducted in accordance with the Rules for Agility Trials.

Fees must accompany entries. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms. Entries are taken on a first received basis. Please provide a copy of your official AKC Jump Height Card, or your dog may need to be measured at check-in by the judge. A returned check will invalidate an entry and a \$25.00 service fee will be charged. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis for all American Chesapeake Club events.

Telephoned, Faxed, or unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions to its acceptance. Entries sent via express mail service, must be indicated "NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED."

Entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted after the entries have closed except as provided for in chapter 14, section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable. There is no refund for duplicate entries. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if the entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season are not permitted at the trial. Entry fees for bitches who come into season before these trials take place will be refunded provided the Trial Secretary receives notice with a veterinarian's letter in writing prior to the start of judging. A \$10.00/day handling/recording fee will be withheld for entries withdrawn due to a bitch being reported in season.

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, violent acts of nature, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

ACC may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against ACC or any official thereof.

American Chesapeake Club (ACC), their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or their dogs, or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to guests and/or children. Please, no baby strollers on the trial grounds.

This Trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are register-able breeds that have obtained ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dogs' physical or mental performance.

Absolutely no puppies under 6 months of age are allowed on agility trial the grounds.

Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and are able to perform all of the obstacles safely.

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the trial committee at this trial will be strictly enforced, including and not limited to the recorded information of this premium list.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up area. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s), guest(s), and children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s), guest(s), and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. The owners or handlers of each dog are solely responsible for being ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. The trial giving club and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service runners or public address system for the purposes of locating or calling dogs that are not brought to the ringside when required.

Dogs qualifying at this titling event, receive credit toward their title. A recording fee is included with entry fees.

The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
